Antimalarial drug discovery and development globally is currently fragmented and uncoordinated. There is an urgent need, in the light of the renewed global attention to malaria, to bring all these projects into a co-ordinated and integrated plan to support the Global Malaria Action Plan (GMAP) to eliminate and ultimately eradicate malaria. The CRIMALDDI Consortium has been set up by its members to develop and publicise such an integrated and prioritised roadmap and an associated 5-year action plan for the discovery of new antimalarial drugs, which it is planned will form the basis of the R&D agenda for malaria drugs in Europe.

This informal session during the MIM meeting in Nairobi offers a chance to tell you about how the project is being carried out, how it relates to other initiatives (like GMAP and MalERA), and how you can help us improve our proposals. This will also offer a chance for you to ask us questions on the project. Afterwards there will be a reception where there will be further opportunities for us to discuss the objectives of CRIMALDDI and how we can collaborate to make it a success
